All courses are suitable for students aged 16+. Maximum class size 15

Standard Course 15 hours per week

- 3 hours in the morning or the afternoon, from Monday to Friday
- Ideal for students who want to combine studying with free time to explore
- General English, Exam Preparation, or English for Work, depending on level

ENGLISH⁺ Course 20 hours per week

- 3 hours in the morning or the afternoon, from Monday to Friday with an extra hour at lunch-time
- Choose from our ENGLISH⁺ options
- 5 additional hours (12:30 – 13:30) to combine with any Standard (15 hours per week) course

Full Immersion Course 30 hours per week

- 6 hours a day, in the morning and afternoon from Monday to Friday

- Not recommended for Beginners (A1) or Elementary (A2) students

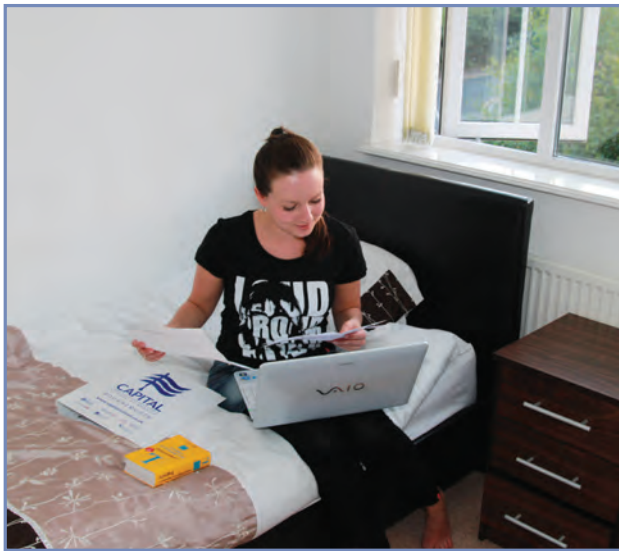

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Homestay is the most popular type of accommodation and provides students with the opportunity to practice their English through staying with an English speaking homestay provider who will provide a homely atmosphere and safe and secure environment.

What is homestay accommodation?

- Your home in Bournemouth.
- Stay with a local homestay provider.
- Practise English outside the classroom.
- Learn about a new culture.
- Near the school; between 10 to 30 minutes walk or a short bus ride. (May require a local bus pass which can be bought at the school).

What is provided by the homestay?

- A safe, clean, comfortable and friendly environment for you.
- Breakfast and dinner (Monday to Friday).
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner (Saturday and Sunday).
- One load of laundry a week.
- Towels and bed linen.
- Internet/Wi-Fi.

What types of rooms are available?

- Single rooms.
- Twin/double rooms (available on request). Ideal when travelling with a friend, partner or colleague willing to share.

What if I have a special diet or allergy?

- On the enrolment form inform the school of any dietary requirements or any allergies you have. This information is important to help the Accommodation Team select the most appropriate homestay provider. (Additional fees maybe required in order to cater for special diets. Please refer to the school website for further information).

Who may live in the homestay Accommodation?

- The homestay provider's family.
- Other students from Capital School of English (up to 3 adults, or 4 Under 18s).
- Many homestay providers in England have pets. They are often considered part of the family.

How are homestay providers monitored?

- The Accommodation Team monitor the quality of service provided on a regular basis.

How much does the accommodation cost?

- Fees vary according to the type of accommodation, time of year and any special dietary requirements.

For young adults (16-19) and young learners (12-15)

Mini-stay courses are offered to closed groups of young adults (16-19) and young learners all year round, with a minimum of 7 in a group.

A typical mini-stay course is designed to balance an academic programme in the mornings (15 hours/20 lessons) with additional cultural and social activities in the afternoon and at weekends. Each group has input into what is studied, how free time is spent and which additional excursions are booked. All levels are offered from beginner (A1) to proficiency (C2) and mixed level groups can also be accommodated.

Academic programmes available

General English – A course based on our General English courses. It is aimed at developing all areas of language, speaking, listening, reading and writing. The focus can be designed to suit the individual needs of the group.

English for work – A course based on our English for Work course that can concentrate on specific functions in the working environment, such as giving presentations or negotiating.

Academic English – A course based on our Cambridge Exam Preparation courses and IELTS courses. It is aimed at developing skills for learners preparing to study at English speaking colleges or universities.

Exam preparation classes – programmes for students preparing to take one of the Cambridge Exams or Academic IELTS, which focus on all or particular skills with modules such as Speak for Success, Grammar for Cambridge, Academic Listening, Effective reading, Vocabulary for IELTS and Writing for Exams.

ENGLISH+ courses (5 additional hours per week) – can be added to a standard (15 hours/20 lessons) course. We have a wide range of ENGLISH+ courses available targeting specific areas of English language. Courses include: Reading & Writing, Pronunciation and Survival English.

Academic programmes for young learners

Project based – Choose any of Capital School of English's Project based topics. This academic programme encourages communication and the use of English in natural situations in a creative and interactive environment. A topic is selected for each week of the group's stay and the language studied is relevant to the topic and varies from level to level and with the ages of the learners. Learners share their final project work in a presentation and/or show to the group leaders and another class.

Possible topics are: The Environment, Film, History, Culture and celebrations, the media and Heroes and Villains.

Exam introductory course – A course for learners preparing or thinking about preparing for Cambridge Exams or Academic IELTS. The course can focus on all or particular skills.

Integration day – This is an additional option for Young Learners (aged 12-18). Learners can spend a day in a local UK secondary school, following the same timetable as an English student.

Social activities and excursions

The academic team and activities team work very closely to ensure that additional activities and excursions are related to the weekly topic.

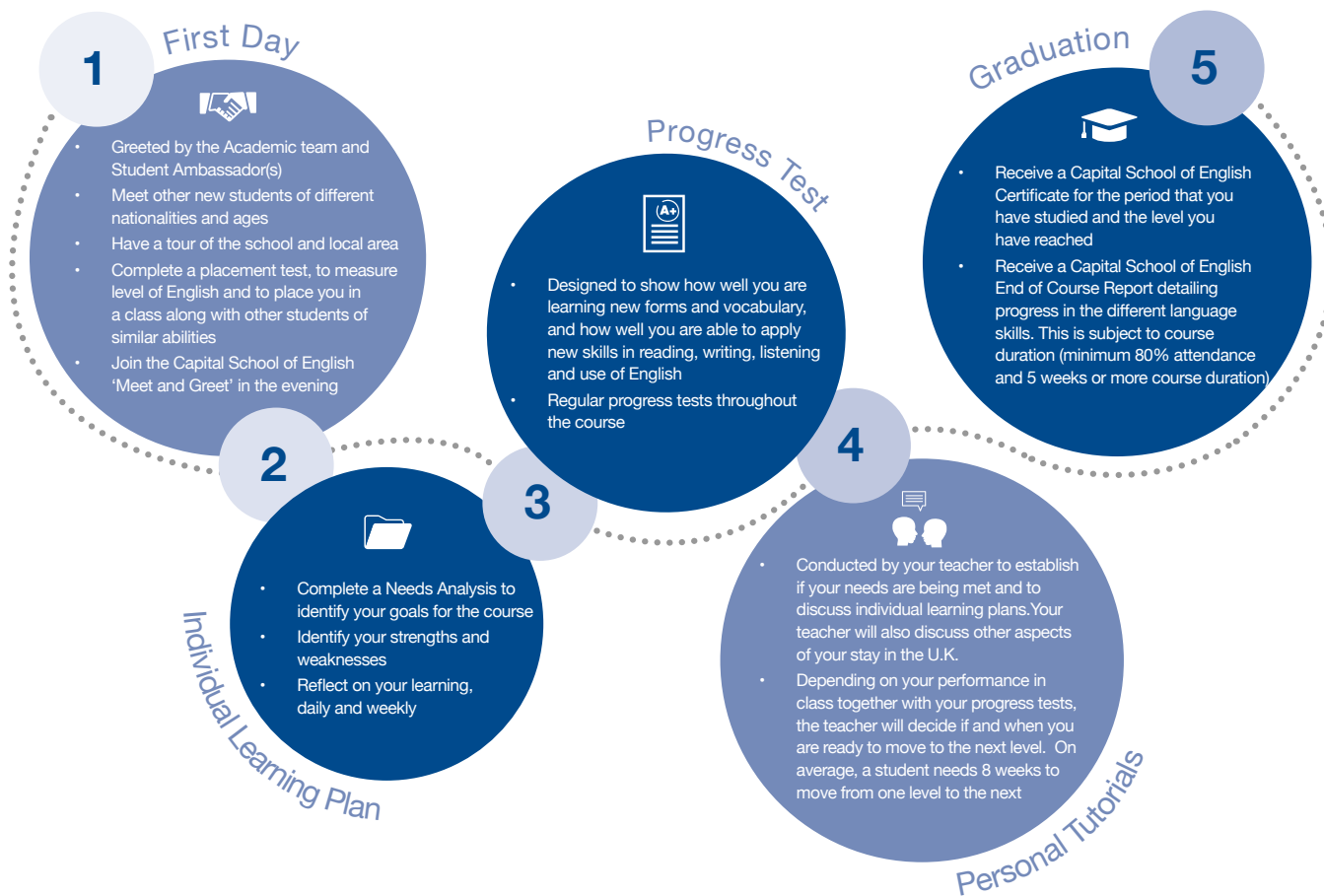

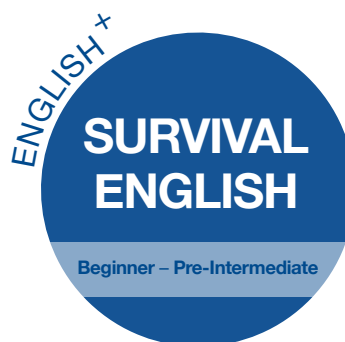

- You will receive your own door key for the residence and your own room key

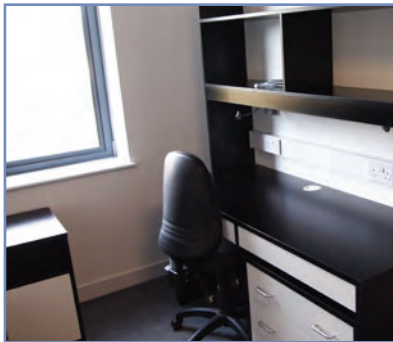

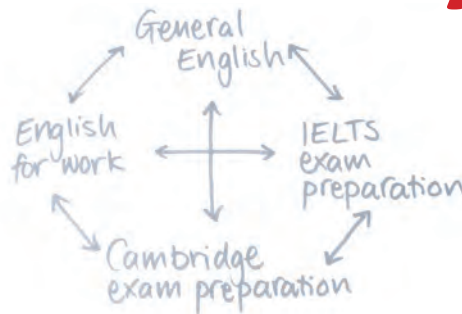

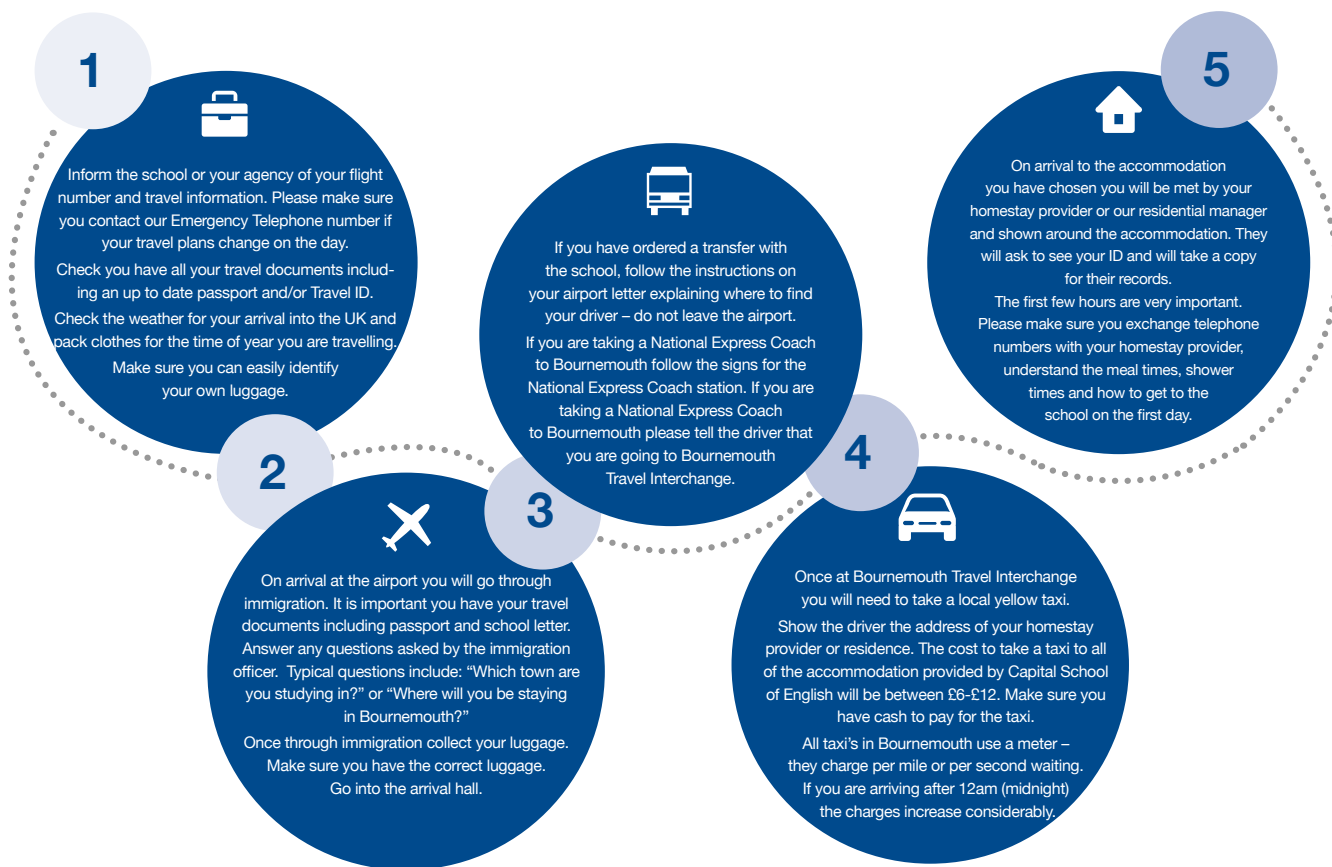
